Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Welcome back to 2017. We commence the year with 584 students and 21 classrooms. This includes 67 Reception students who are starting school for the first time. We not only welcome these children but also students in other year levels who have joined the school. We trust their time at Reidy Park will be enjoyable and rewarding.

Students have settled into their class routines very positively with all classes participating in a Setting Up For Success program in the first weeks of term. The purpose of this program is to have a whole school focus on establishing classroom behaviour and work expectations that will provide a foundation for the year ahead. Each year we have a school motto and this year's is 'Stretch yourself, pursue your personal best'. This motto is underpinned by the importance of students being proactive in challenging themselves, knowing that to get better in anything requires effort and that personal best is about taking pride in individual growth rather than comparing themselves to others.

Uniform and Mobile Phone Expectations

We request all families support our school uniform and mobile phone policy. Our school uniform policy has been endorsed by Governing Council and therefore it is an expectation that all students, every day, attend school dressed in appropriate attire. In regards to mobile phones, students in Yrs 6-7 are required to hand their phones to their class teacher at the beginning of the day. They will then be stored in a secure location. All other year levels are required to hand their phones at the Front Office and collect them at the end of the day. All care will be taken to keep phones safe, however children bring phones to school at their own risk. If your child does bring a phone to school please ensure they follow these expectations, including the importance of appropriate use of this technology.

Staff News

As well as welcoming many new students and their families to our school we also welcome a number of new staff. Sandy Mullen will be fulfilling the role of (acting) Deputy Principal for Terms 1 and 2. Sandy has moved from her role as Principal of Compton Primary School to be at Reidy Park. Teaching staff who have joined the school are Sam Currie (Yr 6/7 teacher and Senior Leader), Kate Symons (Yr 5), Michelle Waters (Yr 4/5) and Daniella Marcucci (Yr 3/4). Jenny Johnson has returned to Reidy Park and will be teaching Performing Arts and Health lessons in the junior primary.

There are also some new staff in the Front Office Administration area: Judy Hunter (Business Manager) and Lisa Hunter (Administration and Finance). A complete list of staffing positions for 2017 has been included in this week's newsletter.

The staff and I look forward to working collaboratively with the school community throughout the year. Supportive and positive home-school partnerships are crucial in providing a great environment for our students to learn and develop. Surf Education

Year 6/7 Students will be attending a 2 day Surf Education course at Port MacDonnell in Week 3. Further information will be sent home tomorrow with students.

Pupil Free (school closure) Day

Staff will be participating in a training and development day on Monday March 27th. The focus of this day will be on writing; strategies for effectively teaching narrative writing and analysing student work in this area.

Absences and Pick Ups during school hours

When children are absent, or there is a planned absence, please provide your child's class teacher with a written note. A note is also required if you need to pick up your child during the day for an appointment. DECD requires schools to keep a record of this information so your assistance with this matter is appreciated.

School Crossing

Please ensure your child uses the designated school crossings when arriving and leaving school. We encourage parents, if walking with their child, to also use the crossing to help model safe pedestrian behaviour. Morning drop off and afternoon pick up times are very busy and the pedestrian crossings provide a supervised area for students to use.

Parent Volunteers

Parent volunteers are a valued support for our school. Please be aware of DECD volunteer and screening requirements in relation to parent volunteers:

What is relevant history screening?

It is a screening process undertaken by the Department for Communities and Social Inclusion (DCSI) Screening unit that involves checking the person's criminal history and any other relevant information that is lawfully available to the Screening unit.

Examples of when a screening <u>is not required</u> for volunteers:

- parents or guardians who volunteer in connection with an activity that involves their own child (such as volunteering within their child's own class).
- one-off guest appearances such as presentations and concert performances that are supervised by screened staff – eg teachers.
- parents involved in one off events such as sports days, working bees and whole of school events including a swimming program which their child is attending.
- parents or guardians volunteering on a Governing Council that is not the employing authority of an OSHC service (Reidy Park Governing Council is not the employing authority of the OSHC service located at the school).

Examples of when a screening is required:

- parents or guardians attending overnight camps or school sleepovers.
- those in close contact with students with disabilities in special classes or schools.
- sports coaches who are not parents or guardians of a child in the team.
- parent volunteers, if their own child is not involved in the service or activity.

*Please be aware that grandparents assisting with class activities on an ongoing basis require a screening clearance.

Applying for a relevant history screening.

DECD have an online screening tool at www.decd.sa.gov.au that will clarify the requirements for people seeking information about volunteering in schools. Once a volunteer has been approved through this screening process, the clearance lasts for 3 years. You can also contact the Front Office staff for further assistance and information.

Bushfire Information

Please be aware of the following information regarding the management of bushfire incidents in our local area.

In the event of a bushfire emergency.

If a bushfire or grassfire is approaching or in the vicinity of the school, the safety of everyone at school is the highest priority. In these situations our school will implement its emergency management plan, which will involve:

- Moving students indoors.
- Fill available containers with water.
- Close windows.
- Work with DECD Security and Emergency Management to manage the situation.
- Alert families via the school's SMS service.

Catastrophic Fire days

Catastrophic fire danger days are forecast when conditions are the worst for a bush or grass fire. On these days, schools that are in a high risk areas may be required to close. Reidy Park PS has a low risk bushfire rating which means on days that are forecast catastrophic, the school will remain open.

Parent Bushfire Information Hotline

The Parent Bushfire Information Hotline operates during business hours, with an out of hours messaging service at other times. The hotline is the best source of current and up to date information on bushfire emergencies. The number is: 1800 000 279.

Excursions and Camps

Weather conditions leading up to, and on the day of these activities will be monitored. If a bushfire is burning on the day of an intended camp or excursion and is likely to threaten the destination or return to the school, the activity will be cancelled.

In the event of a bushfire or grass fire impacting on a camp or excursion that is already underway, our school will liaise with DECD Security and Emergency management unit and the Education Director to determine the most appropriate action to take.

Should children be collected if a bushfire incident is near the school?

Whilst this ultimately a parent choice, please consider the following points:

- Will you be travelling through the affected area?
- Road closures may be in place to manage the situation.
- Has the school directly requested that you pick up your child?
- If your child has been moved to a safe area within the school, they are accounted for and supervised.

As you would be well aware, from time to time there is a need for us to contact you directly in regards to sick children or unforseen emergencies. If you have had some changes to your address, contact numbers, family situation, health issues or you simply need to update details, please contact our Admin staff who will happily make those changes


