# **Reidy Park Primary School Non-Negotiables**

As with all schools, Reidy Park PS balances academic learning with social and emotional learning to help our students become upstanding and productive citizens within our community. Within the umbrella of social and emotional learning falls strategies such as our Zones of Regulation, which I am sure many of you have heard about.

Another tool the school uses to help teach students appropriate behaviours at school are our Non-Negotiable Expectations. These are:

- Wear school uniform
- I keep my hands, feet and objects to myself
- Be in the classroom during learning time
- Place rubbish in bins
- I listen to and follow directions
- Always use appropriate language for school
- Work hard, be kind, be safe

Class teachers constantly refer and explicitly teach what these expectations mean and look like, to help ensure we have an orderly learning environment at school. Please feel free to discuss these expectations with your children at home. Currently classes are focusing on expectation 2.

#### NAPLAN 2021

After an interrupted 2020, all schools will be conducting NAPLAN testing from Tuesday the 12<sup>th</sup> of May through to Friday the 21<sup>st</sup> of May. For our school this will involve students in years 3, 5 and 7 completing 4 tests that take approximately an hour. Please minimise interruptions for these students between 9am and 1pm, as all tests are conducted under formal exam conditions. #### **ANZAC Day Commemorations**

The school was represented by School Captains, School Leaders and School House Captains at the Battle of Kapyong commemoration ceremony. Students listened to a service, laid a wreath and spoke to Battle of Kapyong veteran, Mr. Underwood, who is 1 of only 2 surviving Korean War veterans in Mount Gambier. Mr Underwood thanked our students for attending and helping ensure the memories of fallen Australian soldiers live on. We also met Captain Mathew Ritchie, who is a current serving submariner, in charge of making sure Australian Navy Submarines are in working order and operational. He shared with the students what it was like to serve in a submarine, as well as what his medals and epaulettes represent. Our school Captains Rhys and Sam also attended the ANZAC Day dawn ceremony and were responsible for laying another wreath on the school's behalf. Thank-you to all students for representing our school at these two important events.

# NAPLAN testing 2021 Information for parents and carers

#### NAPLAN testing

The National Assessment Program – Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) assesses literacy and numeracy skills that are essential for every child to progress through school and life.

Students in Years 3, 5, 7 and 9 may participate in the annual NAPLAN tests in reading, writing, conventions of language (spelling, grammar and punctuation) and numeracy.

The assessment provides parents/carers and schools with an understanding of how individual students are performing at the time of the tests.

This year, the NAPLAN Online test window is 11 to 21 May. Most schools in South Australia will undertake testing online, however all Year 3 students will complete the writing test on paper. There are contingency measures to revert to paper testing if required.

# Supporting your child

On its own, NAPLAN is not a test that can be studied for and students are not expected to do so. You can reassure your child that NAPLAN is just one part of their school program and remind them on the day to simply do their best.

It is not recommended that students use services by coaching providers or excessively prepare for NAPLAN testing.

Teachers will ensure students are familiar with the types of questions in the tests and provide appropriate support and guidance.

#### NAPLAN reporting

Individual student performance is shown on a national achievement scale, and a NAPLAN individual student report will be issued by your child's school later in the year.

Students and parents may use individual results to discuss progress with teachers, while teachers use results to better identify students who would benefit from greater challenges or extra support.

# Participation in NAPLAN

Students in Years 3, 5, 7 and 9 may participate in NAPLAN testing. If a child is absent on a testing day, the school may arrange for them to complete the missed test/s another time during the school's test schedule.

If a student has a disability, they may qualify for adjustments to their tests. Students with a disability that severely limits their capacity to participate, or students who have recently arrived in Australia with a non-English speaking background, may be granted a formal exemption.

There are provisions for parents/carers to withdraw their child from NAPLAN testing.

Schools are familiar with this process and a decision should be made with your child's school. Speak to your principal in the first instance.
